The Back Issues from the First Decade are reprints, the best that could be obtained from the original art. However, some of the originals have deteriorated; most were typed on a typewriter and copied by Xerox; and, as Xerox machines of the 1980s could not reproduce grey tones, some of the photographs are very black. Thus the graphic quality of "Beyond Bree" from the First Decade is not as good as that of today. But the *content* is just as good. Nancy Martsch, Editor
